The Wearing of Helmets by Junior Players At Easton & Martyr Worthy C.C



In February 2000 the England and Wales Cricket Board (ECB) issued safety guidance on the wearing of helmets by young players up to the age of 18. At Easton & Martyr Worthy C.C:

- Helmets with a faceguard or grille **must** be worn when batting against a hard cricket ball in matches and in practice sessions.
- Young players should regard a helmet with a faceguard as a normal item of protective equipment when batting, together with pads, gloves and, for boys, an abdominal protector (box).
- Young wicket keepers **must** wear a helmet with a faceguard, or a wicketkeeper face protector when standing up to the stumps.

The club keeps a stock of helmets in a range of sizes to suit players of all ages – these are kept in the 'Age Group Kit Bags'. Parents are encouraged to purchase a helmet for their son/daughter to use when playing at the club. These are widely available and can be purchased for £25 - £30
